THE ROLE OF FOREIGN LANGUAGES IN SHAPING THE PERSPECTIVES OF CITIZENS STUDYING IN OTHER COUNTRIES

Introduction. There is still an urgent problem of foreign language proficiency. Knowledge of languages serves to bring nations closer together and increases the chances of young professionals to succeed in their professional activities. In Ukraine, the quality of training of future young specialists is linked to the need to master foreign languages, which will facilitate the mobility of Ukrainian students in the international space [4].
